Programmes for European students

DBS welcomes study abroad students for either one semester (January or September) or for the full-academic year.

Typical One Semester options include:

- Undergraduate Semester programme - 30 ECTS credits
- Certificate in Global Business (QQI Accredited) - 30 ECTS credits
- Postgraduate Semester programme - 30 ECTS credits

Full Academic Year options:

- Ordinary Bachelor Degree - Level 7
- Bachelor Honours Degree - Level 8
- Postgraduate Degree - Level 9
- Year Long Semester Abroad - 60 ECTS credits

Our European students can choose to study an undergraduate or postgraduate programme with us. Some of our courses include Business, Law, Finance, Computing, Media, Arts, Psychology, Social Science and more.
